

Goal 1: Develop relationships and partnerships to serve and meet the needs of our community


Goal 2: Select a wide-range of diverse projects that improve the quality of life in Schuylkill County.

## **Schuylkill County Youth Summit**

The Youth Summit's mission is to engage, equip, and support our youth to create a great future for Schuylkill County.

The theme for 2018/2019 was to have a positive impact on the opioid and drug use crisis in our region. The students developed a multi-prong approach:

- o Peer-to-Peer communication was enhanced by developing a website. Thanks to Travis Snyder, Skook Recovers and FeatherHawk Productions, for his work with VISION to create www.skookyouth.com.
- o Advocating for the establishment of permanent 'take back' sites throughout Schuylkill County to decrease the amount of prescription substances available in homes.
- o Distributing drug destruction bags to oral surgeons in the county.

The 2019 Youth Summit met at Penn State, Schuylkill on April 11, 2019 with more than 80 students present. Many community leaders shared information with students who then designed responses to these issues. Those present at the Summit honored Kay Jones for her dedication and inspirational leadership of the Schuylkill County Youth Summit.

**Positive Schuylkill: Live, Work, Play** was announced as the 2019 – 2020 focus with panel discussions and breakout sessions facilitating an exploration of this topic and ways to move forward.

The 2020 Youth Summit will be held on March 24, 2020 at Penn State, Schuyklill.





VISION facilitates **Healthy Schuylkill Community** coalitions that address the problem of obesity and lack of exercise and promotes safety and connections in the county.


